

ELECTRIFYING AT BUTTONWILLOW

Buttonwillow's 2 ¹/₂ mile road course was quiet, missing engine sounds and gasoline fumes as the Tesla Corsa group held their track day in March, Founded by a group of Tesla enthusiasts who wanted to try out their cars at a racetrack, the event has grown to encompass drivers and cars from all over the west, with groups designed for first timers and experts. Professionals were available for personalized instruction for new participants. Supervised by long time track day operator Speed Ventures (www.speedventures.com), there is also some competition in the time attack format for those qualified.

Normally, Teslas are driven in the regular street mode,

designed to maximize battery range but for the higher performance models, a track mode is available. Prepared cars, with upgraded brake pads and tires, showed off lap times comparable to Corvettes in a surprising, albeit, quiet display of performance.

Keep in mind that bottom level Teslas cost in the \$40,000 range. The high performance sports models are \$125,000 +. A number of cars seemed to have carbon fiber body parts, lowering kits, trick brakes and a number of completion parts. Then again, speed costs!!

New on the market, with more than 90 sold, is the Rush SR. The creation of Houston's David Hosie, a mechanical engineer with a background in running race teams, the Rush SR has been taking the spec racer market by storm. It clicks all the boxes of handling, reliability, performance and the lowest price of anything in it's class, with 0-60 times in the low three seconds and a top speed of 152 mph.



The 75 inch wheelbase car is powered by a Suzuki sourced water cooled GSX motor, 1000 cc with an 11600 RPM redline and six speed sequential gearbox complete with paddle shifters. A spec race series is in the offing.

If you attended some recent So Cal events, you saw the Rush SR blistering the track with the driver of the Fresno Powersports car, Mike Schneider, blowing off Corvettes at Buttonwillow and taking fastest time of day at the VARA's Willow Spring's Horsethief Mile hillclimb, not surprising with a 145 hp and 935 lbs.

The Fresno Powersports guys (www.fresbnopowersports. com), California distributors for Rush, trusted me to drive it at the VARA Hillclimb and I in turn, promised not to wreck it or break anything. Driving the Rush first feels like you're putting it on; a tight fit but room for all 6'5 of me due the adjustability of the pedals and seat. Rolling out of the pits is the only time you use the clutch, then clutchless shifting both up and down is the norm. Reaching the 11600 rpm redline in each gear, standing on the Rush built binders make it feel like a formula one car (not that I'd know) and cornering currently on soft compound Nankang tires reminded me of a go kart.


Without bragging too much, I went pretty fast quickly,

the car is easy to drive and for most any potential purchasers, they can be assured that no surprises await them.

As a track day car or ready to race in SCCA's prototype 2 class (formerly DSR) or NASA, I can recommend the RUSH as a cost effective, simple to maintain, easy to drive racecar.

Dave Wolin, long time racer, journalist and author managed to not embarrass himself in the road test of the Rush SR



Until 1984, it was in the quaint town of Sunnymead, now known as Moreno Valley and cars would cruise from all over the LA regions even as far as San Diego to experience the 50's atmosphere the Jet claimed homage to.

> New to California, Rich & Penny Pichette moved here in 1976 from Connecticut and purchased the Jet in 1978. Penny, born and raised in Bristol Connecticut, really did not have the knowledge of classic cars, or any cars for that matter until she dated Richard. Well, she told me that she did like a good Ford "Shoebox", years 1949-1951 and of course the 1956 Oldsmobile "Rocket" 88 that was her Dads car he gave to her back in the day.





Starting with around 30 members in the club initially, the Jet soon became "the" place to be for that unique 50's cruisin' car vibe.

In fact, during a Friday or Sat night a cruise to the Jet from another well-known spot called Angelo's in Anaheim, California were "the" destination places to frequent.

That same year, West Coast Kustoms (car club) was born and soon after, Rich organized the first gathering entitled "West Coast Cruisin' Nationals".

The idea raised a couple of eyebrows and in fact attracted a few new friends for Richard and Penny such as Gene Win-

 Malts, Memories and a Penny from Heaven

 field, Ed Roth and George Barris to name a few, and those

 friends soon became life-long members of the Pichette family.

Automotive shows were popular and sprouted everywhere here on the West Coast during this time yet most would only invite cars from 1949 down, and a true "Kustom" was completely out.

The term Kustom, considered to be originally conceived by George Barris as a "Cool" terminology class to describe a car modification (from Mild to Full Kustom) using parts from other makes and models to radically change the appearance to reflect the "vision" of its modifier using leading, chopping or other methods to enhance the original makers lines "further".

There were many classics 1950's and newer and some who took liberty to own, create or drive an actual "Kustom" car needed a place to showcase and belong and that is why Rich set out to do what West Coast Kustoms actually didbring those car owners together to celebrate in what Penny

states later on as some-thing that felt like an annual "family reunion". And in a gradual way from each year to year, the "family" had successfully seemed to be a growing one indeed.

The first year Rich had set out to find the perfect spot for his idea, and Paso Robles was the area that seemed most reasonable to host. They were most "welcoming" to the idea Penny had remembered.





Unlike Tesla's gas powered counterparts, electric vehicles, particularly those driven hard, need recharging, some more frequently than others. Under the radar reporting said that most Tesla's lost 30% of their range after a fifteen minute track session, leading some to plug in at the track between sessions, gaining 30 miles of range per hour. Other drove fifteen miles to the nearest ten outlet Supercharger station on I-5, got a quick recharge and drove back to the track.

Not for everyone, the range limitation, lack of noise and initial cost will keep me from buying one for a while. But our future is electric cars, like it or not!!
