





THE WINNNG EDGE #47

By Mike Lewis

Hi everybody, it is nice getting all this rain as bad as we need it, but I am definitely ready for some sunshine and warmth.

For those of you that are contemplating an engine re-

build or freshen up in the near future, I would like to make a suggestion.

There is a recently released 2-axis single point CNC Valve Seat and Guide machine manufactured by Newen, called the Contour-BB. Pro Tech is a proud owner of this

revolutionary machine. In my opinion this machine practially makes all other seat and guide machines obsolete. With the Newen, chatter marks and undulations are impossible to generate using the single point cutter. Valve seat angles can be changed every one-hundreth of a degree. You can program any valve seat profile into the computer that is advantageous to the seat profile and airflow or duplicate exactly an existing seat.

My suggestion is if you are going to have the seats cut on your heads it would be beneficial to locate one of these machines in your area. If you are unable to find a Newen machine, give me a call and I will try to locate one for you.

Something that has raised its ugly head more so lately than normal is guys bringing in heads where the combustion chamber was actually larger than the bore size in the block. This situation can be very detrimental to airflow, let alone trying to gain maximum compression. If you have your heads off or plan to install new heads check the dimension. It may be necessary to notch the block or return the heads for a set with a narrower combustion chamber.

Museum, a great aircraft collection and close to all the wineries for lunch or a taste !!





vehicles can come on her own. She can manage a stick shift very well thank you; her Jeep has a five speed, is a competent driver and has been since age 14.


Some of the younger new people like the McGuire boy with his 1967 Mustang must come with a parent as they do not have a driver's license. Some have parents that share and support their interest come with them.



As the General Motors brand ultimately focused on delivering the "lifestyle" of vehicle ownership, Pontiac has always owned a special place in North American automotive history.

else on the road.



Created to fill the gap between Chevrolet and Oldsmobile, in its early years the Pontiac brand was known more for its distinctive styling and unique trim elements like "straked ornamentation" – better known to many as the "waterfall" hood trim. While ornate in design, Pontiac's overall style was still conservative, again bridging the brand gap GM was attempting to fill.

Pontiac began to stretch its legs in the late 1950's, under the direction of Bunky Knudson and heavily influenced by a young but aggressive engineering assistant named John Z. DeLorean. Marketed with the "We Build Excitement" tagline, Pontiac curated both fun and desire behind the wheel.

Under DeLorean's engineering direction Pontiac produced a consistent string of iconic vehicles, with models like the Catalina, Firebird, Grand Prix, and GTO – a name taken from one of the most revered sports cars ever produced, the Ferrari 250 GTO.


Pontiac pushed performance to levels unseen in production vehicles – often covertly and almost always successfully. Although GM was not "officially" involved with racing at the time, a Pontiac Catalina driven by "Fireball" Roberts and tuned by the legendary Smokey Yunick won both its qualifying race and the Daytona 500 in 1962. The win on Sunday, sell on Monday ethos became a core part of Pontiac's brand success.

The 1959-60 Pontiac Catalina, now built on GM's b-body platform, was the first production version of Pontiac's "wide-track" performance design. A five-inch wider chassis and wheels moved out to fill the wheel-wells gave the Catalina an aggressive look, plus improvements in both ride and handling. The "wide-track" design would become a key part of Pontiac's promotional efforts for years to come.

The 1960 Catalina has a long, wide, and aggressive stance that grabs your attention – and doesn't let go! The "bubbletop" two-door hardtop with wrap-around windshield and large rear glass, along with a thin c-pillar, increased both visibility and style. Full-length trim, along with twin tailfins, end with quad "bullet" taillights and a stunning rear design unlike anything





Autonomous Cars – Not yet But

Autonomous cars — not yet. This self driving technology isn't ready for prime time. Witness the Teslas crashing with the driver sleeping and more. They can't follow fog lines or deal with rain or snow and just were forced by the government to disconnect it. And the time period when the self drivers, obeying the speed limit and stopping at stop signs, interact with driven vehicles, sounds like it will be horrendous.

That being said, there are some great revolutions in self driving taking place. In Las Vegas, the AAA sponsored shuttle ran back and forth down Fremont Street for years as a test program, albeit at 15 mph. It did it autonomously with help from dozens of sensors and GPS and a safety driver in case of malfunctions. There is currently a robot taxi service being tested; also with a safety driver. A similar test program is underway in San Francisco.


But the real revolution is in the agriculture industry. If you want your forty acres plowed while you're watching a football game, there are a lot of choices. A recent visit to that great farm oriented exposition in Tulare, Ag Expo, along with a hundred thousand others, showed us the latest in autonomous driving for tractors. These process and calculate their own position and speed, and apparently avoid obstacles in the field such as humans, animals, and objects. They travel at about 10 mph, not a speed suitable for automobiles, which makes them much easier to control. Tractors without drivers can be fully autonomous or monitored remotely. Typically, a single operator will oversee a fleet from a remote (but nearby) location. Not far behind tractors are a variety of harvesting equipment, all monitored from your office, home or car.

So, while self driving cars will not soon be available to the general public, autonomous tractors are now the "thing". Drop by your nearest farm equipment dealer and try one out.

The Pharoahs club in Bakersfield had closed due to Covid; no meetings, no shows and activities. Now they're roaring back under new president Curtis Rutledge.



California Introduces Bill to Expand Legacy License Plate Program

Encourage support from lawmakers on this proposal:

California Assembly Member Tim Grayson, a State Automotive Enthusiast Leadership Caucus member, has introduced SAN-supported legislation (AB 378) to expand the state's successful Legacy License Plate Program, which is available for all model years of motor vehicles. Under the bill, the DMV would create and issue an additional series of new specialized license plates resembling designs from the state's past: 1950s (black lettering on yellow background) and 1970s (yellow lettering on blue background). Currently, only the style of the 1960s (yellow lettering on black background) is available for a \$50 fee. Similar to the 2013 law that launched this program, AB 378—if enacted into law—would require at least 7,500 applications for any one particular plate design to be received by the DMV on or before January 1, 2025, in order to go into production. Having passed the Assembly Committee on Transportation, the bill now awaits consideration in the Assembly Committee on Appropriations.


