The Car Vuky Never Got To Drive

I think everyone knows the story of Bill Vukovich, Fresno native, considered by many to be the greatest driver of his generation, With multiple midget championships and two Indy 500 wins (1953 – 1954), he was the only driver to lead the most laps in three Indy 500's.

While leading the 1955 race, he was tragically killed in a

multi car crash on lap 57.

More to this story, Vukovich, long time driver for Superior oil company heir Howard Keck, was scheduled to drive this unusual Quinn Epperly built streamliner, a unique design with an aerodynamic body, unlike the open wheel cars of the day. Unfortunately, the car wasn't finished and Vukovich accepted an offer to drive the Lindsey Hopkins Kurtis 500.

Keck was so disturbed by Vukovich's death in the race that he shelved finishing the car and it lay dormant in storage for many years. Keck turned his interests to philanthropy, funding the Keck School of Medicine at USC, numerous other university projects at Claremont College, University of Nevada, Reno and the renowned Keck Telescope in Hawaii. Keck also owned a Kentucly Derby race winner

Recently a car collector found the car, commissioned some race car constructors to finish it and it's now on tour at various concours events.

So, never raced, this car still remains an icon of Indy 500 and Vukovich history.

Dave Wolin - The Vukovich family, legendary in the Central Valley has been beset by tragedy. I never got to know Bill, but considered his son Bill II a friend. A great driver with 158 starts in USAC / CART racing including 12 at Indy, he recently passed away. His son, Bull III, was Indy rookie of the year in 1988 and the first third generation driver to compete in the Indy 500. He was killed while testing at Mesa Marin in 1990.




