"RAN WHEN PARKED: I KNOW WHAT I HAVE!"

The current resale market for classic cars is down 11-15% for most vehicles in the first quarter of 2025. This is mostly in part to a very tough economy and the high level of consumer uncertainty. The stock market has continued to take a huge hit, and tariffs are negatively affecting the price of aftermarket repair parts. A running/driving/stopping vehicle is valued at a higher price than one that is not. A non-running vehicle is a gamble and may be a simple fix or hiding major issues. Cars from the Southwestern United States cars tend to bring more

money in resale than cars from the Eastern States. California cars tend to bring more money given the climate and the state economy. However, a car is only worth what someone is willing to pay for it. With that being said, our vehicles continue to give us "smiles per gallon" yet many are putting off purchasing or modifying classic cars. There is still high demand for the most select years and popular models. If you are looking to buy or sell, how does one find a fair market price? Do your research and be realistic.

Classic cars are rated and evaluated based on scale of 1 to 6. One being cream of the crop and 6 being a parts car rusting in a field. Hagerty evaluates car values on the first four. Classic. com is another great resource and gathers data on the market for a specific vehicle generation, model and year. According to John "Gunner" Gunnell who was the automotive books editor at Krause Publications in Iola, Wisconsin and former editor of Old Cars Weekly and Old Cars Price Guide here is how classic vehicles are rated.

NO. 1: EXCELLENT - Concourse quality

Top quality original or restored to current maximum professional standards of quality in every area or perfect original with components operating or appearing as new; a 95-plus point show car that isn't driven. 99-point vehicle.

NO. 2: FINE

Well-restored or a combination of superior restoration and excellent original; also, an extremely well- maintained original showing very minimal wear.

NO. 3: VERY GOOD

Completely operable original or "older restoration" showing wear; also, a good amateur restoration, all presentable and serviceable inside and out. Plus combinations of well-done restoration and good operable components or a partially restored car with all parts necessary to complete and/or valuable NOS parts.

NO. 4: GOOD

A drivable vehicle needing no or only minor work to be functional; also, a deteriorated restoration or a very poor amateur restoration. All components may need restoration to be "excellent," but the car is mostly useable "as is."

NO. 5: RESTORABLE

Needs complete restoration of body, chassis, and interior; may or may not be running, but isn't weathered, wrecked or stripped to the point of being useful only for parts.

NO. 6: PARTS CAR

May or may not be running, but is weathered, wrecked and/or stripped to the point of being useful primarily for parts.

Gunnell says, "Another way to think of the condition coding system is to visualize a pyramid in which No. 1 condition is at the top and No. 6 condition is at the bottom. The point of the pyramid has only enough room for the best one or two cars of a particular model. At the next level, the pyramid can fit more cars. At level 3, even more cars can fit and so on. Think of the car or cars at the top of the pyramid as the absolute best of the best. Usually only a single car fits here, although it's conceivable that two could be restored identically. These are not only show cars, but they are

also the show cars that win national awards every time."


Being the Young Guy in the Car Scene. My Experience.

"The second level of the pyramid is filled with all the other show-condition examples of the same model. These are nice cars, but they are just not on par with the top cars. These cars may have a \$25,000 restoration, compared to the No. 1 car's \$100,000 restoration. On level three, you find vintage cars in about the same condition as the late-model used cars you see in the front row of a used-car dealer's lot. These are very nicelooking cars, but they have some minor flaws. They may have been restored ten years ago, and the freshness is starting to rub off. Level 4 brings you the cars like those on the back row of the used-car dealer's lot. These cars have noticeable wear and tear but still have a lot of life and functionality left in them. They are reliable, although the radio may not work, and a new set of tires would be well advised. Cars in level 5 are like those a used-car dealer wouldn't touch these days. Cars in level 6 are even worse. Like we said, "useful primarily for parts."

The best thing to do is to do your own research and be realistic about the vehicle you want or have. You can hire a professional who has the time and the resources to accurately evaluate the condition and market value. While understanding the classic car market is most helpful when creating an asking price or making an offer, a vehicle is only worth what someone is willing to pay for it. That decision is up to you and it is often a decision made with the heart and not the head.

Some folks use the term "driver" as a put down, yet most of us have cars we drive (and occasionally trailer). Some have pavement princesses, while others have trailer queens. No matter what, if it is a driver, then drive it as much as you can! We all have different interest, tastes, brand loyalty, and styles. They can all be appreciated for the vehicles they are as they represent an era gone by. Regardless of the condition of your vehicle or your dream car. They can all be appreciated for what they are. They all work until they don't and they are never done. We have a love/hate relationship with them regardless of if they are Chevy, Ford, Mopar, Packard, Mercedes, or Datsun. Like James Gray of the Clovis Pharoahs says, "You gotta' drive 'em!" I hope you are driving yours right now, or that it's back out on the road very soon.
