





The students that come out of these kinds of programs are our future.

I am usually the oldest person at a car event but feel honored to visit with some of these young and upcoming members of our hobby. Thank you young folks for taking time to visit with the old guy and helping me keep up with the latest trends. I feel honored to be in your presence.





Ford CEO Jim Farley on His 1937 LeBaron Coupe and the Future of Lincoln

It's hard to interview a man like Jim Farley at a place like the Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance. When I met up with him, he had just finished his rounds as a judge, and so everyone who'd been giving him room to adjudicate now wanted to pay their respects to the man who's been a fixture at the Concours for over a decade now.

"I put myself through graduate school as a mechanic at a restoration shop, building cars for this place. When I got invited to be a technical judge for Packards, and I was accepted by the Packard community as someone who knows about hose clamps, and how a '37 and a '38 hose clamp are different, I was like 'I've really made it in my life,'" Farley said, getting a little emotional.



"Of all the things I've accomplished in my life, other than being married to my wife and having kids, being a judge at Pebble Beach is the most important thing for me. When that happened, I cried like a baby," he said.

Farley has earned the respect of his peers and his place as a judge, certainly, and these days he's a bit more popular on the lawn. "Ten years ago, no one gave a shit," Farley said. "But Ford's different. You become the head of Ford, and everything changes."

Farley took over as CEO Ford in 2020, filling the role vacated by Jim Hackett and steering the company through one of the most turbulent eras in automotive history. A global supply crisis, a burgeoning international trade war, wildly fluctuating consumer intent ... all things Farley has had to face in his five years leading the company.

Most recently, he announced a \$5 billion investment to rethink manufacturing, creating a next-generation electric truck assembled using new techniques to radically reduce its cost. It'll be an EV for the masses, but Farley, at least when he's on the West Coast, likes to set the tech aside.

"When I come to Carmel, I want to live in the past," he said. "So I only drive old cars."

Among his West Coast rides, the Ford CEO counts a Lancia Aurelia B20 and a 1960s Mini Cooper, his daily driver when out here. There is, of course, a period FoMoCo piece in his collection, too—this 1937 Lincoln K LeBaron Coupe.

The Model K was built between 1931 and 1940 and was a big step forward for Lincoln, which had been selling the Model L since the company's inception in 1920. Ford

bought the brand just two years later, with Edsel Ford taking the reins and working to move Lincoln further upscale.

"The K was the first true Edsel Lincoln," Farley said. "Edsel was a very tasteful guy. His favorite dog was the greyhound, and this is the classic car that he always wanted to develop. So this is the first true Lincoln, the first Lincoln where Edsel had a 100% say."

Farley's is a 1937 in Ascot Maroon with a gold stripe and a black vinyl top. He ran me down the original build sheet for the car, or at least a copy thereof; the Henry Ford Museum insisted on keeping the original. ("C'mon, it's my car!" Farley lamented.) The machine's coachwork features plenty of art deco—inspired touches, most notably the headlights.

"Mr. Ford was so in love with art deco that he refused to



make these round. He made them oval-shaped, and you can imagine how complicated it was to make a piece of chrome that was oval-shaped, and the whole interior of the car is art deco," Farley said. "The whole car's idea was art deco."



FORD CEO JIM FARLEY ON HIS 1937 LEBARON COUPE...

The coupe's odometer currently sits close to 53,000 miles, 3000 of which Farley has put on over the past five years of ownership. Powered by a 6.8-liter V-12, the LeBaron Coupe makes about 150 horsepower, which, Farley said, is plenty to survive in a modern world. "It does 60 mph, no problem," he said.

But he seems far more enchanted by the Lincoln's sound than its speed. Or, rather, its lack of sound. "You can't even hear it run," he said. "You shut the door, you close the glass, and it's almost impossible to know this car is running. That's what makes it really special. The 12-cylinder was the ultimate in high-end engineering and quietness."

There is, of course, another, more modern class of silent vehicles: EVs. I asked Farley what it would take to get a modern buyer to appreciate that silence and embrace battery-powered cars, rather than staying beholden to internal combustion. He said that modern EVs are definitely best suited for delivering this kind of silent experience today but added



it still isn't necessarily the time to go all-in on electrification. "I think we're starting to discover our brand location for Lincoln that makes sense," he said. "The team really pushed me to have an all-electric lineup, and I refused to do it. And I'm sure glad we didn't. I'm sure glad we didn't."

Instead, Farley sees Lincoln's future as a combination of traditional internal combustion and hybrids, plus newer extended-range EVs with onboard generators, or EREV. "EREV would be a perfect drivetrain for us. All-hybrid and EREV lineup, and maybe a few electric cars, but more on the affordable side," he said. "I don't think we want to make an affordable hybrid as a Lincoln, but an affordable EV Lincoln, with over-the-top color choice and over-the-top interior customization would make sense."

Future Lincoln, Farley said, will focus on redefining luxury. "I think the differentiation is very much the digital experience and the experience itself. Remote service, concierge," he said, concepts that Edsel Ford couldn't have imagined back in the 1930s. Whether those concepts of future luxury will be endearing enough to ensure we're still driving today's Lincolns in 88 years remains to be seen, but this car, Farley said, had something of a head start in that department: "It's an incredible machine. It's just so refined. When you drive down the road, it literally floats. It kind of drives like a '50s car, which in the '30s was really advanced."





1971 DEMON 340

After its success as the '70 Plymouth Duster, Dodge couldn't wait to get MoPar's 108-inch wheelbase coupe for its compact Dart line. That chance came in the fall of '70, when the Demon was added to the '71 lineup. It was the first Dart with an under-110-inch wheelbase. Like the Duster, the Demon came in two models. The Demon 340, which cost just \$18 more than the base six, came with a well-balanced small-blcok V-8, a floor-shifted three-speed, a Rallye instrument cluster, H.D. suspension, E70-14 tires, stripes and dual exhaust. Playing the option list was the name of the game and the 340 had interesting extras including dual-scoop hood with hood pins, a rear spoiler and a "Tuff" steering wheel. The 340 was a card-carrying member of the "71 Dodge "Scat Pack." The Demon was a success, with 69,861 base models and 10,098 Demon 340s built.

'73 Firebirds had new colors, redesigned interiors, new hubcaps and more options. The bumpers were redesigned to meet new federal standards. This made the cars slightly longer, which resulted in the new grille being slightly less recessed. The grille had an egg-crate pattern. Like other T/As that came before it, the '73 had special air dams, spoilers, flares and scoops. The scoops were now sealed and non-functional. A new feature was a large hood decal showing the American Indian Firebird that the car was named for. Enthusiasts dubbed this icon the "screaming chicken." On '73 models, the bird was always black, but the background color varied. It was orange on red cars, black on writer cars and light green on Brewster Green cars. The base engine used in the T/A was a 455-cid V-8 with a single four-barrel carb and 8.0:1 compression ratio that produced 250 hp. Pontiac built 4,550 cars with this engine and 1,420 of them had a stick shirt. For real muscle, buyers could add a SD 455 V-8 derived from Pontiac's racing experiences.


